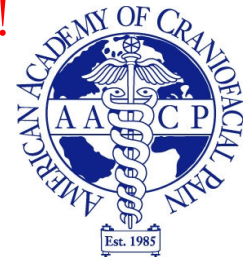

**About this Course:**

*Work in a two-person team to dissect one-half of a fresh, non-preserved cadaver head!* This 16.5-hour course is designed to guide you to a new appreciation of the gross anatomy of the head and neck regions and their relationship to assessment, diagnosis and treatment of craniofacial pain and temporomandibular disorders. Each dissection session will start with an overview, be followed by dissection, and culminate with a review aimed at correlating orofacial pain disorders with the recently dissected areas. Local anesthetic techniques will also be discussed and demonstrated using your cadaver.

Over the course of this rigorous, participation-based program, you will review and dissect superficial facial structures, muscles of mastication, infratemporal fossa, trigeminal nerve (from the Gasserian ganglion and its branches), and the temporomandibular joint.

**Upon completion, you should:**

- 1 Be well-acquainted with the human skull and associated foramina and bony landmarks
- 2 Have an anatomical knowledge of the facial nerve and its distribution throughout the face
- 3 Have a very keen understanding of the trigeminal nerve, its divisions and branches
- 4 Have a clear understanding of anatomical structures encountered while administering local anesthetic injections
- 5 Possess greater understanding of the anatomy of specific and common craniofacial pain disorders
